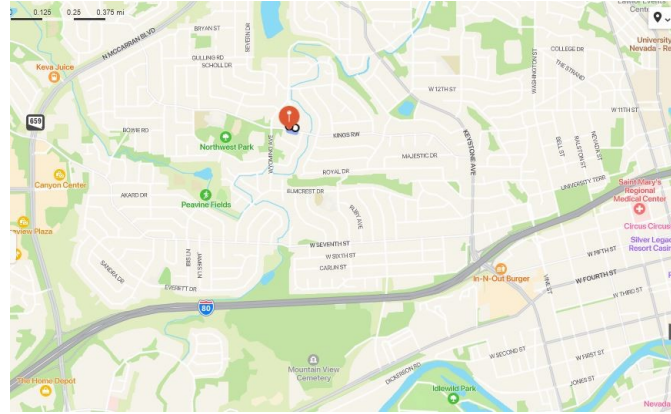

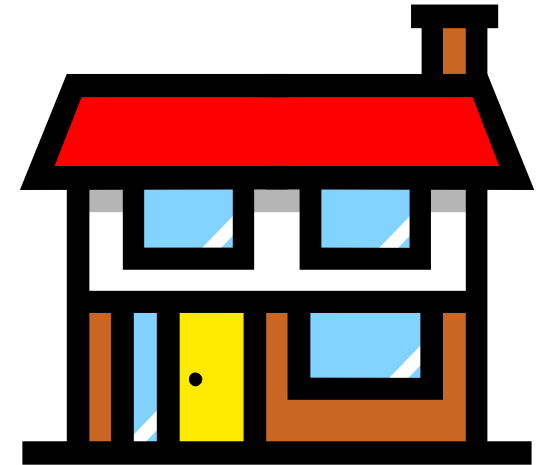

Our Purpose and Vision

To know Jesus, grow in that knowledge, and go teach others to know, grow, and go with a specific emphasis on full-time Christian Education in academic studies for ages birth through Senior Adults.

Alpha Omega Curriculum

CO-OP COST PER CHILD

- New Families that are not members of Faith Ministries \$135 per month for first child, \$110 per additional child in the family.
- Curriculum costs not included average \$350 per year per student or \$35 per month.
- Early enrollment encouraged prices increase after September 12 by \$40 per month per child

All pricing is based on actual cost per child: includes printing and copying cost of materials and crafts; snacks; utility and maintenance cost on building use five days per week for 180 days, 6.5 hours per day. No tuition is charged and no salaries are paid. This is a budgeted item of Faith Ministries. A discount is available to Faith Ministry members and returning co-op members.

PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT

Parents sign the Notice of Intent to home-school required by Nevada law.

Parents and volunteers submit to Minis-

try's security and safety screening. .

Parents volunteer one day (6.5 hours) per week. The week begins Sunday and ends Saturday.

For child safety the ministry campus is closed, doors are locked.



Our goals: To help each child understand the Bible and God's plan for their life. To help each child become a proficient reader. To help each child complete 10 work texts in each subject over the year. Five texts (one in each subject) completed each month. Grades 8-12 curriculum prepare for college coursework. We are not accredited or regulated by the State. We are a church ministry.
